Deleting Lift-Net Data Files

Note: "jobname" will be files and folders within the "lift_net" folder that correspond to the building or complex name or address.

I think the best way to do this without loss of data is to copy the data folders to a safe location, then go back and delete selective files to create additional room.

The Lift-Net data directory (folder) is structured as follows; `/lift_net/jobname`.
All job specific files are in the `jobname` folder.
First copy the entire `jobname` folder and sub-folders to your archive location.

Within the `jobname` folder are folders "carstats, faultlog, grouplog, etc."
Within these folders are folders "cs0501, fl0403, gr1105, etc"
In the above example the cs = carstats, 05 = 2005, 01= January.

You may want to keep all folders with "07nn" (2007 all months) so there will be current data available for reports.

Delete the dated folders of your choice in the following sub folders
Carstats, Grouplog, Faultlog, Pagelog, Replay, and Security.

The folders "HC0506, HC0611, etc" contain hall call data, they have the same naming conventions as the other data files.
Delete the old "HCnnnn" folders of your choice.
